Privacy Notice for CCTV and security devices

Under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019), the announcements of the Personal Data Protection Committee, other relevant laws, and the Personal Data Protection Policy of Thai Takasago Co., Ltd. (“the Company”), the Company has established this Privacy Notice regarding the collection, use, or disclosure of personal data obtained through the Company’s CCTV system and security devices as follows:

1. Scope of Application of the Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice applies to the personal data of individuals who have any relationship with the Company, including employees, customers, workers, contractors, visitors, or any persons who are present within or enter the Company’s office premises, workplaces, or any other areas under the Company’s supervision or control.

2. Definition and Meaning

| “Data Subject” | means | any individual who owns the personal data collected, used, or disclosed by the Company under this Privacy Notice. |
| “Personal Data” | means | any information relating to an identifiable individual, either directly or indirectly, but excluding information of deceased persons specifically. |

3. Purposes of Collecting, Using, or Disclosing Personal Data

The Company collects, uses, or discloses your personal data for various purposes within the following scope:

- 1) To protect your personal health and safety, including the protection of your property.
- 2) To protect the Company’s buildings, facilities, and assets from damage, interference, destruction, or other criminal activities.
- 3) To assist in investigation processes or procedures relating to complaints or relevant inquiries.
- 4) To analyze data, assess, and manage risks, including resolving issues related to the Company’s business operations.
- 5) To prevent, detect, avoid, and investigate fraud, security breaches, prohibited acts, or unlawful actions that may cause harm to the Company or the data subject.
- 6) To comply with applicable laws, regulations, binding orders, legal proceedings, court orders, including the exercise of rights relating to the personal data of the data subject.
- 7) To maintain order and security, and to prevent or mitigate harm to the life, body, health, or property of individuals.

4. Sources of Personal Data Collected by the Company

The Company collects or obtains personal data of the data subject from the following sources:

- 1) Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) system
- 2) Other security devices (if any)

5. Types and Categories of Personal Data Collected by the Company

In general, the Company collects or obtains the following types of personal data:

| Category of Personal Data | Description and Examples |

| Personal Characteristics Data | Information relating to the data subject, such as photographs, still images, video footage, audio recordings, etc. |
| Property-related Data | Information relating to the data subject's property, such as photographs or video footage of personal belongings or vehicles, vehicle license plate numbers, etc. |

6. Legal Bases for the Collection of Personal Data

The Company relies on one or more of the following legal bases for collecting personal data, depending on the context and necessity of each case:

- 1) Compliance with the law
- 2) Legitimate interests
- 3) Necessity for preventing or mitigating harm to the life, body, or health of an individual
- 4) Your consent

7. Disclosure of Personal Data

The Company may disclose personal data collected for the purposes notified to, or consented by, the data subject, or as permitted by law. Personal data may be used and disclosed to the following persons or entities:

- 1) Government agencies or authorities with legal powers, for assistance and support in law enforcement, investigations, inquiries, or legal proceedings.
- 2) Contractual parties, business partners, service providers, or contractors of the Company who are required to perform tasks relating to the data subject.
- 3) Affiliated companies or companies within the same business group, for joint business operations, including but not limited to Takasago Thermal Engineering Co., Ltd., a legal entity under the laws of Japan.
- 4) External service providers, as necessary to ensure the prevention or mitigation of harm to the life, body, health, or property of you or others.

8. Cross-Border Transfer of Personal Data

In the normal course of the Company's operations, which involves the use of data storage technologies and internet-based communication, it may be necessary to use or disclose personal data by transferring such data to individuals located abroad or to international organizations. This includes contractual parties, business partners, and service providers of the Company, as well as affiliated companies or companies within the same business group located overseas for the purpose of carrying out joint operations or business activities. Personal data may also be used and disclosed through the use of information and communication technology tools such as email, office programs, cloud storage, web storage, and various applications, whose service providers commonly host servers in foreign countries. The destination countries or international organizations receiving the personal data may have data protection standards that are inadequate or inconsistent with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019), depending on the applicable laws of each respective jurisdiction.

9. Retention Period of Personal Data

The Company will retain personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes stated in this Privacy Notice, or not less than the retention period required by applicable laws. In general, the Company retains data collected from the CCTV system and other security devices (if any) for a period not exceeding 10 days.

However, the Company may retain personal data for a longer period if it is considered that such data or documents are legally significant and should be kept for at least the period necessary for exercising legal rights, enforcing rights, or as required by the applicable statute of limitations.

10. Rights of the Data Subject

The Company respects and strictly adheres to the rights of data subjects as prescribed under the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019). The data subject is entitled to the following legal rights:

- 1) Right to Access and Obtain a Copy – The right to request access to and obtain a copy of personal data.
- 2) Right to Request Data Transfer, Send, or Portability – The right to receive or request the transfer of personal data.
- 3) Right to Object – The right to object to the collection, use, or disclosure of personal data.
- 4) Right to Erasure / Right to be Forgotten – The right to request the deletion, destruction, or anonymization of personal data.
- 5) Right to Restrict Processing – The right to request the suspension of the use of personal data.
- 6) Right to Rectification – The right to request the correction or updating of personal data.
- 7) Right to Withdraw Consent – If consent has previously been provided, the data subject has the right to withdraw such consent at any time.
- 8) Right to File a Complaint – The right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority in the event the Company violates or fails to comply with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019).

11. Security Measures for Personal Data Protection

The Company has implemented appropriate and legally compliant security measures to prevent unauthorized or unlawful loss, access, use, alteration, modification, or disclosure of personal data. These measures will be reviewed periodically, or whenever necessary, to ensure consistent effectiveness and to comply with technological developments.
